The court requires clarification of each parent's gross income, the basis for any hardships requested, and the percentage of parenting time enjoyed by each parent.

Modified Guideline child support shall be calculated at the time of hearing. The parties shall file with the court and serve on all parties updated income and expense declarations (form FL-150) with pay stubs from March 1, 2020 to present attached.

The Court intends to adopt new springing language indicating that language in any prior orders which include administrative relief without further order of the court is no longer applicable.
