TENTATIVE RULING: No appearances necessary. This petition for dissolution was filed May 9, 2018. Petitioner has not filed a Proof of Service (FL-115) of the Summons and Petition. The court cannot proceed with any orders until Proof of Service is filed. Petitioner has been ordered to file a proof of service (form FL- 115) at every case management conference and has failed to do so. On the court's own motion, the matter is set for an Order to Show Cause regarding dismissal pursuant to CRC Rule 3.1340 (dismissal after two years for delay in prosecution). The Order to Show Cause hearing shall be set on November 17, 2020 at 10:00 a.m. in Department 3. If Petitioner fails to file a proof of service or otherwise respond to the Order to Show Cause, the matter will be dismissed. The Clerk of the Court shall provide notice of the OSC hearing.

TENTATIVE RULING: No appearance is necessary. This petition for dissolution was filed April 24, 2019. Proof of Service (FL-115) of the Summons and Petition is filed. Request for Entry of Default entered on April 13, 2020. The matter awaits entry of default Judgment. To complete the divorce by default, Petitioner must complete and submit the following Family Law forms: (1) Declaration Regarding Service of Declaration of Disclosure (FL-141); (2) Declaration for Default or Uncontested Dissolution (FL-170); (3) Judgment (FL-180) – 5 copies; (4) Notice of Entry of Judgment (FL-190); and (5) 2 stamped envelopes of sufficient size and with sufficient postage to return the Judgment and Notice of Entry of Judgment – with one envelope addressed to Petitioner and one envelope addressed to Respondent. Petitioner is referred to the court’s Family Law Facilitator for assistance. The Family Law Facilitator is available for telephone appointments by calling (209) 257-2627. The matter is set for further case management conference on March 31, 2021 at 10:30 a.m. in Department 3.
