The Agency filed a motion for modification of child support on June 2, 2020 at its own request. Current support orders entered on 10/22/2018 set child support at \$-0- per month, payable by Respondent (Mother). These orders were based on the following Guideline calculation inputs: Respondent's monthly gross income of \$2510 per month and 50% parenting time. The moving party has the burden of showing changed circumstances since the last support order. The court has retained jurisdiction retroactive to the date of filing the motion for modification.
